| Type | Method | Example |

| General Waste Non-recyclable packaging from deliveries of lab consumables and equipment Paper towel after handwash or cleaning non-hazardous spillage | Black bin liner House services remove these regularly from the lab Excess waste should be placed in the general hoppers by Schuster back door (waste room) Please be considerate and do not over-fill bags |   |
| Paper, plastic bottle, cans recycle | Recycling bins in the corridor. NO GLASS |   |
| Mixed glass bottles & jars | Recycling bin in the waste room NO broken glass |  |
| Metal waste recycle | Metal skip in the loading bay |  |
| Large Equipment/furniture | Contact House Services for safe disposal DO NOT leave in corridor | Tony in reception or: Stephen.K.Smith@mancester.ac.uk |
| Cardboard cage, plastic bottle cage, Electrical cage | Cages in the waste room next to the loading bay Cardboard to be flattened before placed in cage |  |
| Small battery recycle | Battery recycle bucket, in the waste room at the loading bay |  |
| Non-Hazardous Liquids Always check risk assessment first | Non-hazardous liquid can go down the sink |  |
